

BRECKINRIDGE COUNTY FISCAL COURT

An ordinance relating to the establishment of 911 emergency telephone service for Breckinridge County and funding therefore:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of KRISS 65.790 (3), the Breckinridge County Fiscal Court must levy certain fees, to be collected from the local telephone subscribers in order to fund the 911 emergency telephone service, and

WHEREAS, the Breckinridge County Fiscal Court needs the assistance of Bell South Telephone Company and the Brandenburg Telephone Company in billing and collecting said fees;

BE IT ORDAINED by the Breckinridge County Fiscal Court:

Section I. Breckinridge County will establish an Enhanced 911 Emergency Telephone Service.


Section II. A fee for the initial installation and maintenance of the 911 system shall be charged to each local exchange telephone subscriber. Said fee shall be billed to each subscriber by Bell South Telephone Company and the Brandenburg Telephone Company commencing July 1, 2001, on an individual exchange lines basis in the amount of one dollar (\$1.00) per month.


Section III. Until such time as this emergency telephone service is fully implemented by the purchase, installation and operation of the necessary equipment, the fees collected by the utilities named herein be remitted to the Breckinridge County Fiscal Court and held in escrow to meet the costs and expenses of this system.

Section IV. The provisions of this ordinance are severable. If any sentence, clause or portion or part of this ordinance, or the application thereof is for any reason found to be unconstitutionality or invalid, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect or repeal any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses or sections or parts of this ordinance.


