ORDINANCE NO. 081202

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
ADDRESSING STANDARDS FOR ROAD NAMING, HOUSE NUMBERING
AND ROAD SIGNS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF COUNTY OF BRECKINRIDGE,
COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Breckinridge County Fiscal Court has determined that in order to provide the residents of the unincorporated areas of Breckinridge County with adequate and responsive emergency services, utility service, postal service and other private and commercial service it is necessary to establish a uniform addressing standard. This standard will prescribe the proper method for numbering property, naming, classifying and identifying roads within the jurisdiction of Breckinridge County Government.

WHEREAS, all houses and other buildings of residence or business shall receive addresses in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance. Road names and classifications shall be designated in accordance with the provision of this ordinance.

WHEREAS, the Breckinridge County Fiscal Court desires to designate the Breckinridge County 911 Office as the county agency responsible for the administration and enforcement of the Address Standards outlined in this ordinance. They shall have the responsibility to assign new addresses and change addresses that do not meet the standards outlined in this ordinance. They shall coordinate the naming or renaming of roads within the County, maintain the county road inventory, and purpose revisions to this ordinance when necessary to maintain continuity in Addressing Standards.

WHEREAS, the County will adopt and approve the Rural Frontage Interval Addressing System which was established by the United States Post Office.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Breckinridge County that it hereby establishes the Address Standards for road naming, house numbering and road signs for the unincorporated areas of Breckinridge County as follows:
