BRECKINRIDGE FISCAL COURT
ORDINANCE NO. 081202-B

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING
ADDITIONAL COURT COSTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF
COSTS RELATED TO COURT FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the Kentucky General Assembly has enacted legislation allowing county fiscal courts by Ordinance to impose additional costs to district and circuit courts;

WHEREAS, the enabling legislation passed by the General Assembly is codified in KRS 23A.220, KRS 24A.185 AND KRS 64.091;

WHEREAS, the additional fees and costs assessed hereby on district and circuit court cases are for the purpose of paying expenses for courthouses, bonds related to them, and administrative expenses of the circuit and district courts;

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF BRECKINRIDGE COUNTY, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

1. In Circuit civil cases, a fee of \$25.00 shall be added to the filing fee;
2. In Circuit criminal cases, a fee of \$25.00 shall be added to the court costs the defendant shall pay;
3. In civil cases that are appealed from Circuit Court to the Court of Appeals, a fee of \$25.00 shall be added to the filing fee;
4. In all traffic offenses, a fee of \$10.00 shall be added to the court cost for each traffic case;
5. In all misdemeanor offenses, a fee of \$20.00 shall be added to the court costs for each case;

6. In all District civil cases, a fee of \$10.00 shall be added to the filing fee (excluding probate, small claims and mental health cases).

7. For service of a subpoena, the person requesting the service shall be charged an additional fee of \$10.00 for the Sheriff's Office;


8. For service of a civil summons, the person requesting the service shall be charged an additional fee of \$10.00 for the Sheriff's Office.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption by law. Thereafter, the Clerk of the Breckinridge Circuit Court shall no later than monthly remit all fees and costs collected hereunder to the Finance and Administration Cabinet in Frankfort, Kentucky for dispersal back to the Breckinridge County Fiscal Court.

Said fees shall be expended by the Breckinridge County Fiscal Court in accordance with KRS 23A.220, KRS 24A.185 and KRS 64.091.

This Ordinance shall remain in effect after its adoption until repealed by the Breckinridge County Fiscal Court or by operation of law.
