ORDINANCE NO. 121100

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REPEAL OF THE
LICENSE FEE IMPOSED ON INSURANCE COMPANIES
ENGAGED IN THE BUSINESS OF INSURANCE WITHIN THE
COUNTY OF BRECKINRIDGE, KENTUCKY:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF COUNTY OF
BRECKINRIDGE, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1: The license fee for the privilege of engaging in the business of insurance imposed on insurance companies within the county of Breckinridge by Ordinance No. 031300 is hereby repealed effective the 1st day of July, 2001 and Ordinance No. 031300 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: The finance officer of the county is hereby directed to transmit a copy of this ordinance, and any amendment thereto, to the Commissioner of Insurance, Commonwealth of Kentucky.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall become effective on the 1st day of July, 2001.

This ordinance was read in open session of the Breckinridge County Fiscal Court for the first time on the 11th day of December, 2000 and was read for the second time and adopted in open session in the Breckinridge County Fiscal Court on the 21st day of December, 2001.
